GATE EXAMINATION


Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering (GATE) is a national level exam that primarily tests the understanding comprehensive of various undergraduate subjects in Engineering/Technology/ Architecture/ Science/ Commerce/ Arts. GATE 2023 will be a computer-based test (CBT) which is being organized by the Indian Institute of Technology Kanpur. The exam will be conducted by IISc Bangalore and seven IITs (IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Guwahati, IIT Kanpur, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Madras, IIT Roorkee) and on behalf of the National Coordination Board - GATE, Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India (Gol). GATE 2023 will be conducted in 29 test papers.

EXAM CENTRES

GATE 2023 Examination will be conducted at specific centres in selected cities and towns in India, and selected cities outside India. GATE 2023 is planned to be conducted at following cities outside India: Dubai (UAE), Dhaka (Bangladesh), Kathmandu (Nepal) and Singapore.

ELIGIBILITY & OPPORTUNITES

A candidate who is currently studying in 3rd or higher years of any undergraduate degree program OR has already completed any government approved degree in Engineering/Technology/Architecture program /Science/Commerce/Arts, is eligible to take this exam. Qualified GATE score can be used for seeking admission and/financial assistance to: (i) Master's direct Doctoral programs programs and in Engineering/Technology/ArchitectureScience/ Commerce/Arts and (ii) Doctoral programs in relevant branches of Arts and Science, in the institutions supported by the MoE and other Government agencies, subject to fulfilling the admission criteria of the admitting Institutes. Further, many Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have been using the GATE score in their recruitment process.



SCHOLARSHIPS
